ENRICHING LEARNERS THROUGH EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

At Little Flowers Public Sr. Sec. School, Shivaji Park, Shahdara, we believe that kids are those delicate exotic plants that need right environment to blossom into good human beings. We provide perfect opportunity to all the students according to their inclination. Learning happens almost everywhere and our students learn from almost every person and everything. We are already aligned with the ideas incorporated in NEP 2020. Skill education is given priority over information. All the students from Nursery to XII conduct STEM activities to understand the concepts given in the text book. They have created thousands of partially and completely working models. Their economical and eco-friendly mosquito repellent

incense sticks composed of parthenium grass, cow dung and charcoal were appreciated at national level in Science Congress. They have successfully prepared edible cutlery by making bowl and spoons using wheat flour and jaggery.

We let the kids learn counting by picking fallen leaves. We make them understand the value of water

conservation by showing them rain water harvesting system. We make them save electricity by installing solar panels. Compost pits teach them to segregate biodegradable products. We show them best practices because example is better than precept. This is the magic of experiential learning. We take it as a social obligation to produce ethical future custodians of the world.



LFPS, Shivaji Park, Students Shine in Children Science Congress

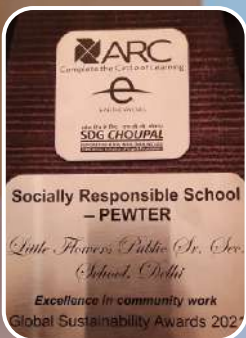


Two students took part in the event under theme of ‘Science for Sustainable Living’ with sub-theme of ‘Social Innovation for Sustainable Living’

Two students from Little Flowers Public Sr. Sec. School (LFPS), Shivaji Park, Gurkirat Kaur and Ojaswi Aggarwal, made their institute proud by winning laurels in the Children Science Congress.

Both the budding scientists participated in that event under the main theme of ‘Science for Sustainable Living’ with the sub-theme ‘Social Innovation for Sustainable Living’. They prudently chose the topic ‘waste water management in school premises’. They gave shape to their work and pledged that not even a single drop of water would be wasted at school. They collected data of water consumption by the students during practicals in labs and estimated that if they conserve that much of water used in biology lab, about 144 litres of water, can be saved in a month.

With the help of their guide teacher Rashmi Saxena, they stored that waste water and prepared a physical filter to clean that water. They also developed a testing kit to calculate the quality of that water. Their work was highly appreciated by the judges. The School Principal, Neeta Dua and LFPS Managing Director, Rohit Dua applauded the little scientists for making their mark in Young Innovators Challenge.

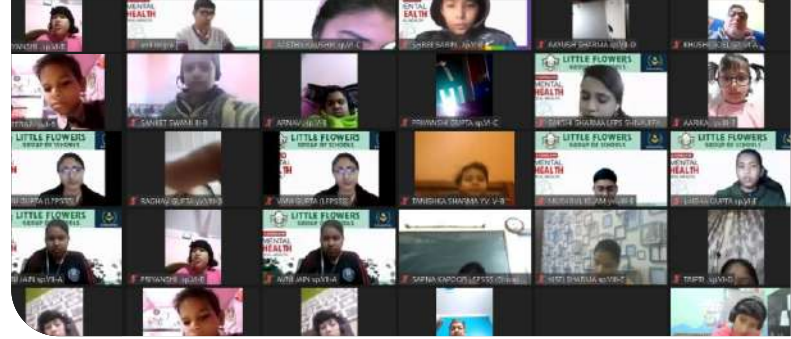

The commendable victory of these students proves that goals are attained not by strength but by perseverance.

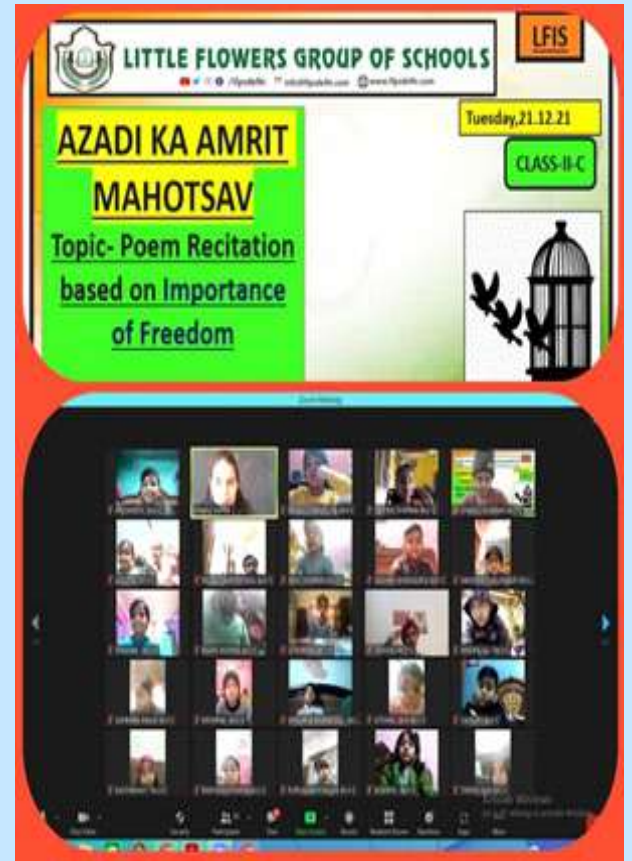


Republic Day *celebration*

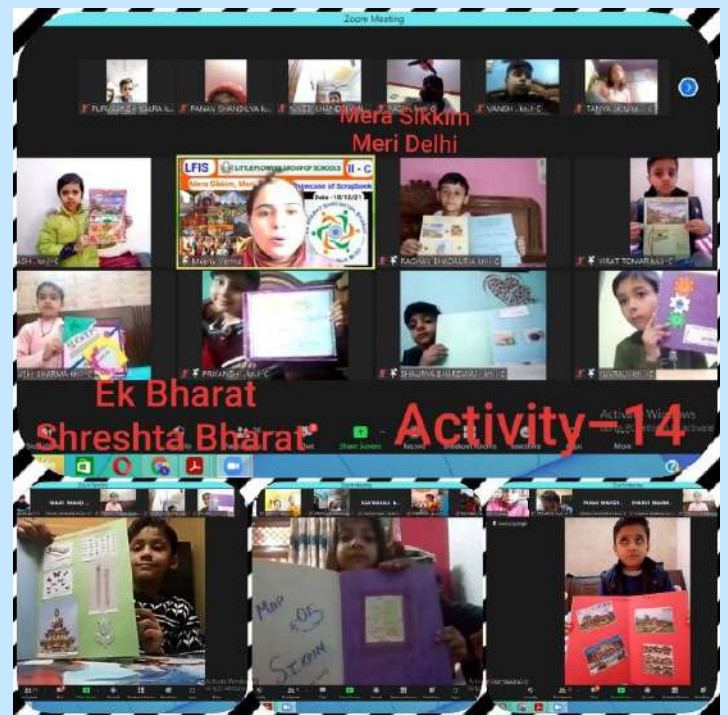

Eco Crusaders, Eco Ambassadors

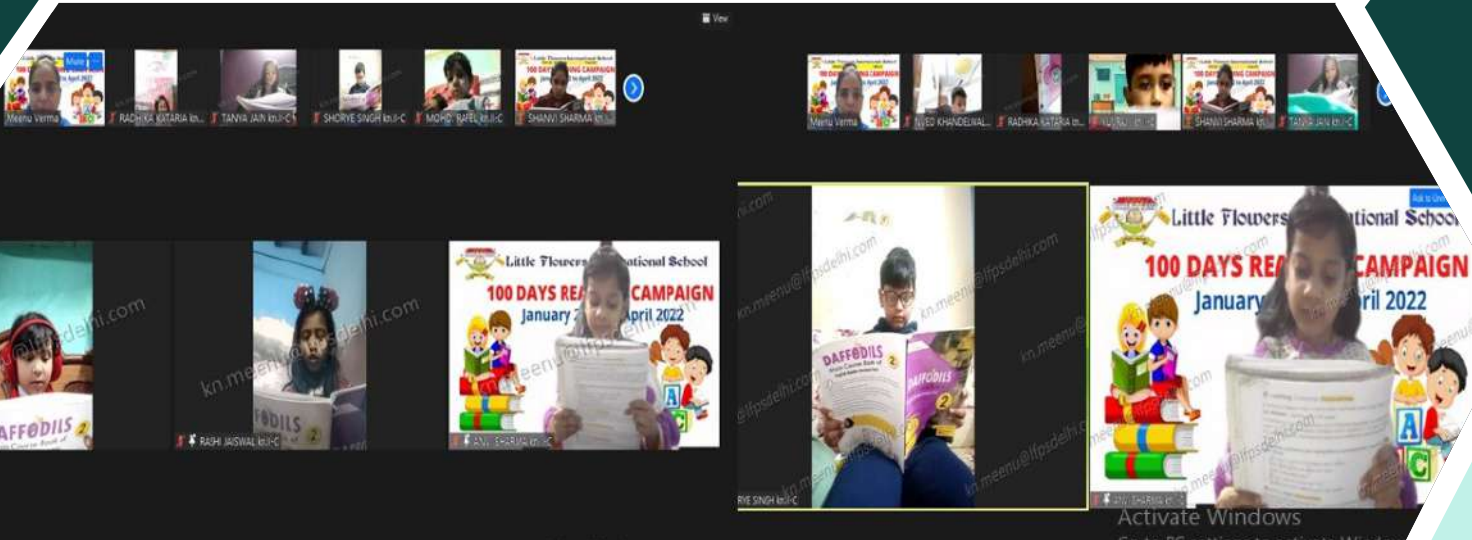

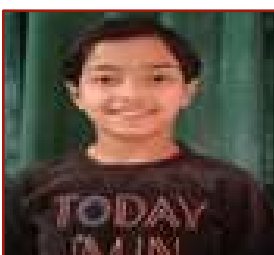
