The students of classes IX and X planted as many as 45 potted plants, including Aloe Vera, Tulsi, Mint, Fenugreek, Neem.

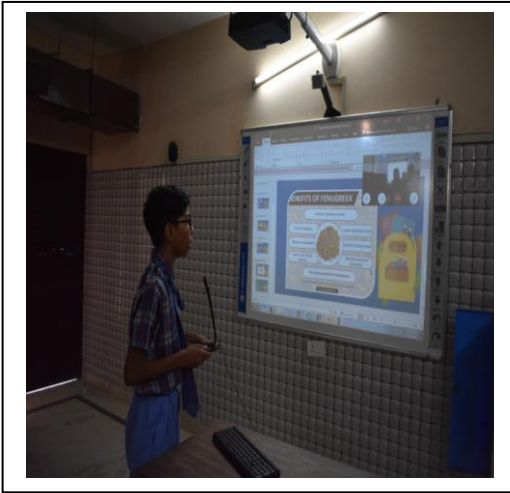
This garden was open for the parents on 19th and 20th of August, 2018. The students had given extensive knowledge to them under the guidance of concerned teacher.
