DISASTER RISK REDUCTION

The students of IX and X were indulged in LAB SESSION under ISA activity-4 “DISASTER RISK REDUCTION”. They searched out various preparedness methods and did a comparative study on India, Nepal and Japan.



Fire Drill was conducted to make students aware how to act judiciously at the time of Fire Hazard. To ensure the safety of the students at the time of evacuation, teachers were deputed at various exit points. This drill checked the readiness of the school to face any such situation.
